



Dart Player Qualifications



League Requirements

League requirements must be completed by January 1, 2011.

Minimum of 96 games played in leagues for an IAMOA operator over no less than 10 weeks of play plus:

- 24 games of '01 for '01 events, 24 games of Cricket for Cricket events
- 24 games of '01 for Team, Mixed Doubles and Combo events

Singles '01	Player must have at least 24 games of '01 or play highest level.
Singles Cricket	Player must have at least 24 games of Cricket or play highest level.
Doubles '01	Both players must have at least 24 games of '01 or play highest level.
Doubles Cricket	Both players must have at least 24 games of Cricket or play highest level.
Mixed Doubles Combo	Both players must have at least 24 games of '01 or play in highest level.
Team	Each player must have at least 24 games of '01. If any player does not have '01 stats but does have Cricket stats, the team will be placed in the highest division.

All '01 games must be Open In/Open Out format to be used for classification purposes. All Cricket games must be split bull to be used for classification purposes. The 24 games for a player skill rating can be played in no less than four (4) weeks of league play and can be included in the total 96 games required for participation.

All games must be played on equipment owned by the IAMOA operator.

Registration is only available through an IAMOA operator. No onsite sign-ups will be accepted.

All players must be NDA and IAMOA sanctioned. Entrants must be at least 18 years of age.

All doubles and team members must meet these requirements through the same operator.

Open Masters Ratings*

NOTE: Open Master events have two divisions in Open Singles and Open Doubles only.

'01 Events:

In Open events, any player with a 29 PPD or above will be considered a Master-rated player in all events. Master-rated players may be placed in the highest level for an event. In double and team events, Master-rated players will play no lower than Level 2. Two Master-rated players must play in the highest level for that event.

Cricket Events:

In Open events, any player with a 3.4 MPR or above will be considered a Master-rated player in all events. Master-rated players may be placed in the highest level for an event. In double and team events, Master-rated players will play no lower than Level 2. Two Master-rated players must play in the highest level for that event.

***Players with a skill rating of either a 29 PPD or 3.4 MPR will be considered a Master-rated player in all events during the tournament, both '01 and Cricket.**

Substitutes and Onsite Alternates

Substitutes

The four (4) highest skill ratings will be used when calculating a team skill. It is helpful to use players with similar skills as substitutes.

On-Site Alternates

Only a Charter Holder's league administrator can make player changes onsite. He or she must have stats and a copy of the entry form with them. No entries will be accepted at the tournament. Players must have equal or lesser stats to the person they are replacing to make the change. Master players are Masters in a Mixed Doubles or Team event regardless if they have higher stats. Master players in an Open Singles or Doubles event can only substitute in their respective division.
