DART TOURNAMENT DEADLINES

February 22-25, 2018

November 1, 2017	⊙ State Dart Tournament entry is available online by logging on to the NDA website: www.NDAdarts.com .
December 11, 2017	⊙ All players participating in the State Dart Tournament must be sanctioned by the NDA and IAMOA.
January 7, 2018	⊙ Dart League requirements must be completed for all players entering the State Dart Tournament. ⊙ State Dart Tournament entries and fees are due. All entries must be sent to IAMOA offices or be entered online. Entries submitted after January 8 will be subject to a \$25 per certificate late fee. All late fees MUST be paid by cashier's check, money order or credit card. ⊙ Stats due to the NDA office for all players participating in the State Dart Tournament.
January 14, 2018	⊙ All State Dart Tournament entries and fees are due. No entries will be accepted after this date. All entries must be sent to IAMOA offices. There will be an entry review period January 16-18, 2018 to allow players to verify their entries and correct mistakes.
January 31, 2018	⊙ <i>Deadline to make hotel reservations for Dart Tournament to get the discounted rate. Rooms at the Wyndham may sell out well before this deadline, however.</i>

POOL TOURNAMENT DEADLINES

April 4-8, 2018

February 18, 2018	⊙ All players participating in the State Pool Tournament must be sanctioned by the VNEA and IAMOA. ⊙ Pool League requirements must be completed for all players entering the State Pool Tournament. ⊙ State Pool Tournament entries and fees are due. All entries must be sent to IAMOA offices. Entries submitted after February 18 will be subject to a \$25 per team late fee. All late fees MUST be paid by cashier's check, money order or credit card.
February 28, 2018	⊙ All late State Pool Tournament entries and fees are due. No entries will be accepted after this date. All entries must be sent to IAMOA offices.
March 12, 2018	⊙ <i>Deadline to make hotel reservations for Pool Tournament to get the discounted rate. Rooms at the Wyndham may sell out well before this deadline, however.</i>
April 16, 2018	⊙ Master and A List drop requests for the 2019 State Pool Tournament are due.

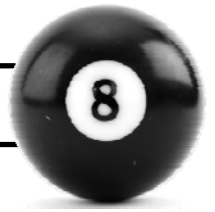

OPERATOR QUALIFICATIONS



To participate in the IAMOA State Dart Tournament, an operator must:

- Be a member in good standing of the IAMOA.
- Be a member in good standing of the NDA.
- Send league statistics at the beginning, middle and end of league play for each dart league.
- Sanction 100% of league players with NDA and IAMOA.
- Leagues must be played on operator owned equipment.

To participate in the IAMOA State Pool Tournament, an operator must:

- Be a member in good standing of the IAMOA.
- Be a member in good standing of the VNEA
- Sanction 100% of league players with VNEA and IAMOA.
- Leagues must be played on operator owned equipment.

Tournament Staffing Fee:

In addition to providing one worker for tournament set-up or teardown, each Operator is required to pay a **\$200 fee per tournament**. This fee will be used to pay tournament staff during the tournament. (Excludes set-up and teardown. Tournament set-up and tear-down staff will not be paid.)

If you are interested in working at the tournament, please submit your application to the IAMOA office by emailing info@IAMOA.org. Workers will receive \$10/hour during the tournament and shifts are in 6 hour increments.

Tournament Staffing Policy and Penalties:

Charter Holders are required to provide qualified staff support for the State Dart and Pool tournaments. Charter Holders sending players to the tournaments must provide:

Dart Tournament:

- One worker for tournament set-up or teardown, as scheduled.

Pool Tournament:

- One worker for tournament set-up or teardown, as scheduled.

Charter Holders who send players to an IAMOA Dart or Pool tournament, but do not send a qualified person to work the required hours, will be subject to the following penalties:

First Offense: \$500 fine per shift** missed.

Second Offense: \$1,500 fine per shift missed.

Third Offense: One-year ban from tournament play, \$1,500 re-instatement fee after the ban is served.

Fourth Offense: Five-year ban from tournament play.

**An offense is considered one scheduled shift at a single tournament. If you miss one shift at the Dart tournament and one shift at the Pool tournament in the same year, it is considered two offenses.

Tournament Event Format:

- All events will be double elimination.
- All Singles, Doubles and Triples events will be double elimination—race to 2 except the following:
 - * Open Masters Singles—race to 4.
- All Team events will be best 3 of 5.
- Team and Doubles events will use the Freeze Rule unless specified differently.
- All Master events will diddle.
- Mixed Triples will be 701, stacked score with no freeze rule.
- Ladies Masters Singles Combo will be best 3 of 5.

Standard League Game Formats:

Standardized league results are the only accepted statistics.

All recorded player-skill ratings are achieved using the actual darts thrown. In addition, the following are standard formats for game play to calculate a player-skill rating:

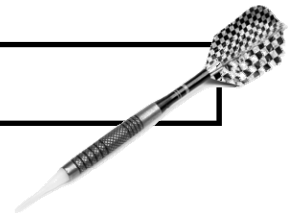
'01: Open In/Open Out format*, full 50 point bull

Cricket: Split 50/25 point bull's eye

All games must be played with 8' foul line and 15 1/2" target face.

*Double in/Double Out games count as games played, but stats must be kept separate. Double In/Double Out games will not be used for classification. If that is all that is provided for a player they will play in the highest level for that event.

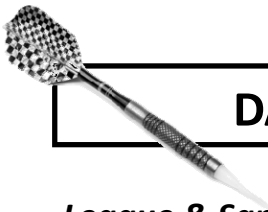

DART TOURNAMENT ELIGIBILITY & CLASSIFICATION

League & Sanction Requirement

- A. All players must be at least 18 years of age.
- B. All players must have a minimum of 96 games played in leagues for an IAMOA operator.
- C. Games must be played between January 2, 2017 and January 7, 2018 and obtained in no less than 10 separate weeks of play.
- D. All games must be played on operator owned equipment.
- E. All Doubles, Triples and Team members must meet league requirements through the same operator.
- F. All players must be sanctioned by the NDA (\$8) and the IAMOA (\$2) to participate in the tournament.

Classification

1. Players **must have a valid skill rating** or they will be classified at the highest level.
2. **All players must be entered with their highest known player-skill rating, from league, for the qualifying period.** This is the responsibility of the Charter Holder. Accuracy of player abilities are dependent upon proper submission and documentation from the Charter Holder. The highest known player-skill rating is determined by taking the highest player-skill (PPD/MPR) rating from a league season for the qualifying period of January 2, 2017- January 7, 2018, including the current league season (remember this must be a minimum of 24 games in no less than ten (10) weeks of league play in the same league season). All stats are based on darts thrown.

For example, Pete played in the following leagues for Acme Vending:

Spring 2016 ending May 15	PPD 24.50
Summer 2016 ending August 30	PPD 23.50
Fall 2016 ending December 15	PPD 25.50
Spring 2017 in play with 24 games over ten weeks at time of submission	PPD 25.75

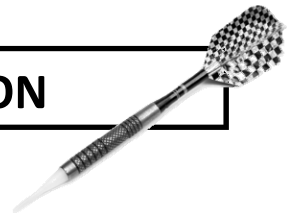
The highest known player-skill rating for this player for tournament entry would be the 25.75 PPD from the spring 2017 season currently in session. When providing player skills, the figure should be carried out two digits past the decimal.

3. **Players must have at least 24 games in a single season for the format they are entering.** All members of the team must meet this requirement. These games must be played over no less than four (4) separate weeks in a single league season and can be included in the total 96 games required for participation.

<u>Singles '01</u>	Player must have at least 24 games of '01 or play highest level.
<u>Singles Cricket/Combo</u>	Player must have at least 24 games of Cricket or play highest level.
<u>Doubles '01</u>	Both players must have at least 24 games of '01 or play highest level.
<u>Doubles Cricket</u>	Both players must have at least 24 games of Cricket or play highest level.
<u>Doubles Combo</u>	Both players must have at least 24 games of '01 or play in highest level.
<u>Team and Triples</u>	Each player must have at least 24 games of '01. If any player does not have '01 stats but does have Cricket stats, the team will be placed in the highest division.

4. Player **ability assessment may be determined by the Tournament Committee** based on known ability, performance in other tournaments and previous year's performance.
5. **Players that placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in the previous year's tournament will be leveled one division higher than they played the previous year.** Performance of all team members will be considered and teams that do not have all of the original players may still be moved up at the discretion of the Tournament Committee.

DART TOURNAMENT ELIGIBILITY & CLASSIFICATION



Master Rating

Players with a skill rating of either a 29 PPD OR 3.4 MPR and above will be considered a Master-rated player in all events, both '01 and Cricket during the tournament.

NOTE: Open Master events have two divisions in Open Singles and Open Doubles only.

'01 Events:

- Any player with a 29 PPD or above will be considered a Master-rated player in all events.
- Master-rated players may be placed in the highest level for an event.
- In Doubles and Team events, Master-rated players will play no lower than Level 2.
- In Triples, Master-rated players will play no lower than Level 1. There will be a Master level based on the field.
- Two Master-rated players must play in the highest level for that event.

Cricket Events:

- Any player with a 3.4 MPR or above will be considered a Master-rated player in all events.
- Master-rated players may be placed in the highest level for an event.
- In Doubles, Triples and Team events, Master-rated players will play no lower than Level 2.
- Two Master-rated players must play in the highest level for that event.

Substitutes and Onsite Alternates

Substitutes: The four (4) highest skill ratings will be used when calculating a team skill. It is helpful to use players with similar skills as substitutes.

Onsite Alternates: Only a Charter Holder's league administrator can make player changes onsite. He or she must have stats and a copy of the entry form with them. No entries will be accepted at the tournament. Players must have equal or lesser stats to the person they are replacing to make the change. Masters players can only substitute in Masters events for Singles and Doubles and in the highest division in Mixed Doubles, Triples and Team events.

Player Documentation:

The following documentation must be submitted to the IAMOA prior to January 7:

- A. That each player entered has played the required 96 games.
- B. The highest known player-skill rating for each player entered.

Documentation must include league ending statistics for all seasons and leagues that occurred between January 2, 2017 and January 7, 2018, that include players you enter into the tournament. If your spring 2017 season is not yet complete, and the players have played 24 games in either '01 or Cricket over a minimum of 10 weeks of play, you should send league statistics to-date for that league.

Your documentation must be labeled IAMOA DART TOURNAMENT. All players entered into the tournament must be highlighted or starred (*) on your league ending statistics. If you are sending statistics via fax, players must be starred (*) because the highlight will not transfer by fax. Highlighting tournament players allows staff to quickly verify 96 games and skill ratings.

DART TOURNAMENT ELIGIBILITY & CLASSIFICATION

Qualified Equipment

League locations can only have dart machines that meet the definition of Qualifying Equipment. Only league games played on electronic dart machines that correctly calculate Points Per Dart (PPD) and Marks Per Round (MPR) as outlined below are eligible for tournament entry. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to require verification from any Charter Holder of equipment used for qualification.

Dart machines manufactured by the following companies are approved as qualifying equipment based on the specifications outlined above: Arachnid, Inc., Cyberdine d.o.o*., Gaelco Darts S.L., Phoenix Darts**, NSM-Löwen Entertainment

*Only the Cyberdine Turnier Darts / model: CYD-03-15,5" can be used to qualify for IAMOA Tournaments.

**Only Models VSP, VSS and VS4 sold and distributed by Phoenix Dart, Inc., a subsidiary of Hong Kong International

If a software or hardware kit from a non-manufacturer sponsor is installed on a previously qualifying dart machine, the machine specifications of that equipment are no longer verifiable. Therefore, that equipment can no longer be used in league play to qualify players for IAMOA Tournaments.

Dart machines manufactured by the following companies are approved as qualifying equipment, but will expire per the schedule below.

Through 2018 IAMOA Dart Tournament - Medalist Corporation equipment purchased prior to January 1, 2014. Qualifying Medalist equipment must be on the Elite platform, which includes the following: Spectrum Avanti Elite (T), Spectrum Avanti Elite (M) and Spectrum Genesis Elite (which requires the Spectrum Avanti Elite Conversion Kit).

Through 2019 IAMOA Dart Tournament - Shelti equipment purchased prior to July 1, 2014. Includes boards branded as Valley/Cougar.

POOL PLAYER ELIGIBILITY & CLASSIFICATION

Age & Sanction Requirement

- A. Entrants must be at least 21 years of age unless participating in the Junior Team event.
- B. Junior players must be 9-20 years of age.
- C. All players must be sanctioned by the VNEA and the IAMOA to participate in the tournament.

League Requirement

- 1. Games must be played between March 1, 2017 and February 18, 2018.
- 2. League nights consist of majority of games played per night. **Maximum of 2 league nights per calendar day.**
- 3. All games must be played in leagues run by and on equipment owned by the IAMOA operator.
- 4. All team members must meet league requirements through the same operator.

Singles	Player must have at least 12 league nights and 36 games.
Open Team	Four (4) players must have at least 12 league nights and 36 games; 1 player with 8 league nights and 24 games. Must have 2 original players from the same team.
Ladies Team	Three (3) players must have at least 12 league nights and 36 games; 1 player with 8 league nights and 24 games. Must have 2 original players from the same team.
Masters Team	Four (4) players must have at least 12 league nights and 36 games; 1 player with 8 league nights and 24 games. No requirement for number of original players.

Classification

- 1. Only one A Division Player can be on a roster on a B Division Team
- 2. No Master Division Player can be on a roster on a B Division Team
- 3. Only one Master Division Player can play on an A Division Team

Men's B Division	Top 32 Players to A Division
Men's A Division	Top 16 players to Masters Division
Ladies Singles	Top 8 players to Masters

Teams

Men's B Division	Top 8 teams to A Division

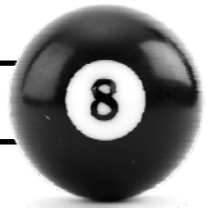
Master and A Players must participate in the tournament in their respective division for the total number of years listed to qualify for removal from the list:

Master Players: 2 years
A Players: 5 years*

Master list players will never be moved to the B division once they are on the Master list.

**All Ladies Masters are on the A List, but are eligible to be removed from the A list after two years of participation.*
